How To Play!

You are the owner, general manager and coach of your very own college football franchise. It is up to you to decide the starters each week. Predict who has the best chance to score the most points week in and week out using the unique Head2Head scoring system. Wisely spend your \$100 million bankroll to field the best possible team. All of the college players listed on the first page of this booklet have been assigned a salary based on their performance in the 2010 season and their expected performance in 2011. The players you select will earn fantasy points for your team based on their on-field performance and the scoring system on page 8.

You must not exceed your \$100 million regular season budget and your team must consist of ten (10) players at all times: (1) Quarterback, (3) Running backs, (3) Wide Receivers/Tight Ends, (1) Kicker, (1) Defensive/Special Teams and (1) Flex (any position player, not a team defense).

HEAD2HEAD COMPETITION!

Your team is placed in a 30-team league; each league is made up of six 5-team divisions. For the first 14 weeks you are matched against an opponent within your league to battle Head2Head. These match ups decide your team's win/loss record. To find your team's season-long schedule please check "Schedule" on the website. Watch out, interdivisional play takes place weeks 12-14 and these match-ups will settle any playoff qualification tiebreakers!

WE'LL KEEP YOU UPDATED!

Each week you may review all of your reports online including your opponent's weekly boxscores, and upcoming rosters after the H2H trading deadline. You will also receive full league standings, scores, weekly Top 100 teams from all leagues and more!

CHANGE LINE UP!

During the season, your players may get injured, benched or turn out to be just rotten! You're the owner so you can call the shots and dump any under performers on your roster. To learn the trading ropes, flip to page 5.

How To Change Lineup

It's easy to trade players in H2H College Fantasy Football. You do not trade with another owner, instead you will simply decide which players you want to drop and add based upon your salary cap. Players dropped and added must play the same position. Keep in mind that your resulting team salary total must not exceed the Salary Cap. So check your numbers and check your math, it is your responsibility. All trades become effective for the next Head2Head scoring period if made by the appropriate deadline.

INDIVIDUAL TRADES

You may make individual player trades by clicking on the "Change Lineup" button on your "My Team" page. You will be prompted to purchase trades or use the existing trades on your account. Make sure you have enough to complete all of your roster moves.

FULL-TEAM TRADE CERTIFICATES

Complete Package subscribers receive one Full-Team Trade Certificate (FTC) while Season Pass Members receive three Full-Team Trade Certificates. FTC's may be redeemed online or by phone. If you have a FTC remaining on your team account, a link will appear across the top of the website that reads "Use Trade Certificate" (this button will not appear if you don't have any FTC's on your team account). Each FTC may only be used one time. It is recommended that you save one for the playoffs when many roster changes may be necessary.

NOTE: FTC's are not available in the "Change Lineup" Section.

FTC's don't carry over to other teams or another season.

OPPONENT'S ROSTER

One hour after the final trade deadline your opponent's roster will be available to view using the boxscore link.

TRADE PACKAGES

Each trade costs \$3.00 or you can buy a money-saving package of 10 trades for \$25, 20 trades for \$40 or 50 for \$90. A trade consists of dropping one player and adding another. Trades can be submitted each week in one of two ways: Internet or Phone. You can purchase trades over the phone with one of our agents or on the website. When you want to purchase trades online, go to the "Change Lineup" link and choose the option you would like. It isn't required to change your lineup when you purchase them, but don't forget to get them in by the appropriate deadline!

1 Step 1 asks how you will be paying for your trades.

Choose an option from the list provided, Enter credit card information if necessary, then click the submit button to go to Step 2.

2 Step 2 shows your current roster with drop down boxes available to make your roster changes.

Just click on the drop down box to view a list of players at that position. Click on the name of the player you wish to add and his name will now appear in the box. Your new salary total will appear in the box at the bottom of the page.

You can make all roster changes to this team in this manner.


Once you have made the changes for your roster then click the submit button to go to Step 3.

- 3** Step 3 will show your new roster. At this point you have the option to continue forward to finalize your trades or to go back to make any additional changes.

Once you have reviewed all of the changes to your roster and you are satisfied with the new roster, click on the finish button to go to Step 4.


If you wish to make additional changes to the roster, go back to Step 2 by clicking on the gray back button. Do not use the back button on your browser.

TRADE DEADLINES

All trades will become effective with the first college football game of the next H2H Period only if your trade(s) is made by the appropriate trading deadline immediately preceding that next H2H Period. **Players may be traded each week from Tuesday at 9:00 AM Eastern (6:00 AM Pacific) until 7:00 PM Eastern (4:00 PM Pacific) on Friday via the phone and until 11:30 AM Eastern (8:30 AM Pacific) on Saturday via the Internet.**

INTERNET TRADING

Internet trading is the easiest way to make your trades. Simply go to our website and log-in with your email address and password. After logging in you will see the "My Teams" page, which shows your teams for all Head2Head games. To change the lineup on your team, just click on the team name.

Internet trading will begin Tuesday, September 7 for Week #2. The weekly internet trade period for is Tuesdays from 9:00 AM Eastern (6:00 AM Pacific) until 11:30 AM Eastern (8:30 AM Pacific) each Saturday. Internet trading will shut off automatically at the deadline so please do not wait until the last minute to begin your trades. Internet trades must be **completed**, not just started, before the deadline.

PHONE TRADING

To change line up by phone it is important to have the following information available:

- 1) Member ID #** and **2) Team Name**, **3) Player ID #'s** for all players you are dropping and
- 4) Player ID #'s** for all the players you are adding. Please give each trade to the sports agent in drop/add order. (For example, "I want to drop 104 and add 111, drop 213 and add 210, etc."). Make sure to have the sports agent read back all of the players' names that you have dropped and added, the total salary of your new roster and provide a confirmation number.

Phone trading will begin Tuesday, September 7.

How To Keep Score!

Each week, your players earn points for their actual performance. If you score more points than your opponent, you post a win for that week! There are no fractions of points.

YOU CAN FOLLOW ALONG!

Just follow the example on the next page. To keep score, visit our website or look for the boxscores in your daily newspaper or favorite online site.

In the newspaper you will find a boxscore for every game played the day before. The boxscore gives the statistics of each player in every game. Record your team score and your opponent's score on the official H2H weekly scorecard (sample provided for copy or printing on page 9) or just check your boxscore online on Sunday morning after all scores have been updated.

PLAYOFFS

After the final H2H Period, the two teams from each five-team conference from each league with the best win/loss records will automatically qualify for the H2H playoffs. In addition, four teams from each league that did not automatically qualify for the H2H Playoffs will earn "wildcard" playoff berths. These wildcard teams will be the four teams with the greatest cumulative H2H regular season point totals of all non-automatic playoff qualifiers in their respective leagues. In the event of a tie for the final wildcard position, all teams will qualify for the playoffs as a wildcard. All first place regular season division winners will receive a \$105 million salary cap for use during the H2H playoffs. All second place regular season division winners will receive a \$102 million salary for use during the H2H playoffs. All wildcard teams will receive a \$100 million salary for use during the H2H playoffs.

All team win/loss records are erased and all playoff qualifiers start with zero points. The H2H Playoffs begin with the College bowl games. There will be 2 trading periods for the playoffs. The first round of the playoffs will include the bowl games through December 31, 2010. The second round of scoring for the playoffs will be the bowl games from January 1, 2011 until the National Championship game. Your first round trades for the playoffs must be in before the first bowl game. Your trades for the second round must be submitted before the first game on January 1, 2011. Cumulative points throughout the H2H Playoffs determine the H2H Playoff winners.

TIEBREAKERS

Game – In the event your team's H2H point total equals that of your opponent, the team with the lower team salary total will post a win for the week. If the salary totals are the same, the team with the most cumulative points wins.

Division – If two teams have the same win/loss record at the end of the H2H Regular Season, the team that won the H2H match-up will finish with the higher division ranking. Official H2H College Football Salary Cap Rules

H2H College Football is a game of skill and is void where prohibited by law.

- Affiliations.** *Head2Head ("H2H") College Football* and Head2Head Sports is owned by Sports Enthusiast Media, LLC.
- Optional Service Package.** You may enter *H2H College Football* for \$19.95 for a Complete Package or \$9.95 for a Starter Package. All payments must be in U.S. funds. Entries mailed or transmitted with insufficient funds or information or an invalid credit card may be disqualified and will not be processed until the correct amount of payment or information is received. Do not send cash. Make check or money order payable to "Head2Head Sports", Visa, Amex, MasterCard, and Discover credit cards are accepted.
- Eligibility.** *H2H College Football* is open only to residents of the United States of America (excluding Vermont), Puerto Rico, and Canada (excluding Quebec). THIS CONTEST IS SUBJECT TO ALL FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LAWS. You must be 18 years or older as of September 2, 2010 to participate. THIS CONTEST IS VOID WHERE OTHERWISE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW. All employees and immediate family members of Head2Head Sports, their sponsors, advertising, production, and fulfillment agencies are not eligible for prizes. Shutouts will receive 10 points, 1 through 6 points allowed will receive 6 points, 7 through 13 points allowed will receive 4 points, 14 through 20 points allowed will receive 2 points, 21 through 27 points allowed will receive 0 points, 28 through 34 points allowed will receive (-2) points, 35 through 41 points allowed will receive (-4) points, and 42 or more points allowed will receive (-6) points. Points allowed include ALL points scored by the opposing team. Return yards and two-point conversion yards do not count. Scoring is based only on the games actually played each week.
